

## COURT REPORT

in the daytime for a felony, two counts of receiving stolen property, possession of a class B drug, larceny under \$250, and possession of liquor by a person under 21; June 30, 2007 charges of larceny of a firearm, malicious destruction of property, breaking and entering a vehicle during the night time and larceny over \$250, and June 15 charges of malicious destruction of property, five counts of breaking and entering a vehicle during the day time for a felony and six counts of larceny over \$250.

Patrick P. Irving, 43, of Hyannis, Mass., had Feb. 18, 2007 charges of unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and not having an inspection sticker, dismissed on payment of \$300 in court costs.

An outstanding warrant for the arrest of Ernestas J. Jaloveckas, 27, of 33 Surfside Lane, on Oct. 6 charges of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol, negligent operation of a motor vehicle, leaving the scene of an accident with property damage, failing to stop for police, a marked lanes violation and speeding will remain in place.

Archip Jaree, 49, of 77 Bartlett Road, had Nov. 8, 2007 charges of unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle and driving an unregistered motor vehicle dismissed prior to arraignment.

A pretrial hearing for Parker N. Swift, 26, of Boston, Mass., on July 2, 2007 charges of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol, negligent operation of a motor vehicle, a marked lanes violation and speeding, was continued to Feb. 19.

An outstanding warrant for the arrest of Caroline K. Taylor, 61, formerly of Nantucket, for failing to appear in court on a March 30, 2005 charge of failing to attend a jury session, was inactivated because she was not able to be located.
